ENTRY TO SEAL A CRIMINAL OR
ARREST RECORD PURSUANT TO
ORC 2953.32

DEFENDANT

This matter came on before the Court for hearing on the application for sealing of the Applicant's record of criminal charges, conviction or arrest. Upon consideration thereof, the evidence and arguments, the Court finds that the Applicant is first offender, that there is no criminal proceeding against the Applicant, that the Applicant's rehabilitation has been attained to the satisfaction of the Court, and that the sealing of the record of Applicant's conviction is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all official records pertaining to this case shall be sealed and all indexed references thereto shall be sealed, that the proceedings in said case shall be deemed not to have occurred, and that the Applicant's conviction shall be expunged, subject to the exceptions and provisions set forth in Revised Code chapter 2953, as now enacted and hereinafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant is hereby restored to all rights and privileges not otherwise restored by termination of sentence or probation or by final release on parole.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no officer or employee of the State, or any political subdivision thereof, except as authorized by Division (D) and (E) of Section 2953.32 of Ohio Revised Code, shall release, disseminate, or make available for any purpose involving employment, bonding, or licensing in connection with any business, trade, or profession to any person, or to any department, agency, or other instrumentality of the State Government or any political subdivision thereof, any information or other data concerning any arrest, indictment, trial hearing, conviction, or correctional supervision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of this Entry shall be served by the Clerk of Courts on the following by mail:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that none of the foregoing persons shall inspect or use said records not permit the inspection or use of said records except as provided in Revised Code Chapter 2953 as now enacted and as hereinafter amended.
